Pilot scheme for Stroud District Council

CEEC are soon to be part of a pilot scheme for Stroud District Council. We will be installing a Smiths environmental combined solar thermal p.v panels with a water to water heat pump on a sheltered housing block.

This will supply heating and hot water for all communal areas – including a laundry area and hair dressing saloon.

This installation will take part at the end of September.
